Food Safety Programs



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WHAT IS SERVSAFE®?

ServSafe® is a nationally recognized program developed by the National Restaurant Association, that provides food safety training, exams and educational materials to food service managers.

WHY ATTEND?

ServSafe® participants who score 75% or above on the exam become certified and are qualified to become instructors of food handlers. An added bonus is that under the new code this certification may be able to lower your risk assessment score which may result in fewer visits from your County Health Sanitarian.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Food Service Managers who are not certified by an accredited Food Safety Course. The Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations state that "at least one employee with authority to direct and control food preparation and service shall be a food protection manager who has been certified by an accredited program." Class space is limited. Registration is on a first come first serve basis.

FOOD SAFETY WORKS

This training is targeted to all workers who handle, prepare, or serve food in retail, food service, or community settings. It is not the Food Protection Manager Training required by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Upon passing the exam participants earn a 3- year food safety certificate.
